First, I would convey the idea to my students that the class is their platform for learning, which they do best by putting ideas into action, at least in the form of discussion and intellectual problem-solving; I would convince them that they need to interact with one another, practice what they learn with one another, and share knowledge and inspire one another. I would give problems to groups rather than to individuals; for instance, I would let groups to summarize a difficult essay in their own language by letting them first discuss the meaning of the essay, then draft parts of the essay, then merge them together, then pass the combined draft around to make sure everyone agrees whether the full draft covers all the key points of the essay, whether the draft is easy to understand, and so on. I would gradually increase the amount of time students spend on group work, while gradually teaching them how to work collaboratively in effective manners; for example, I would start by asking students to discuss a given problem in groups and let one member each report to class what they discussed but as they learn to work as groups I would let them come up with problems that they decide as significant as groups and then discuss solutions, thereby letting them decide how to manage limited class time. Since there is no privilege of information technology, I would assign tasks at the end of the class and give them five or ten minutes to plan and divide work for the next class meeting; I would let students write down their plans and track their progress if there is anything that runs into multiple class periods.
